• Engage in discussions with the Chamber of Commerce and Travel Drumheller to consider the long-term outlook for the Visitor Information Centre given the shifts in visitor preferences for information access and potential changes to the area resulting from the Town of Drumheller Parks & Recreation Master Plan.

Exploring Transportation Opportunities

Fall 2024 - March 2026+

- Acquire funding through grants and other contributors to enable this work that includes two key components: a feasiblity study and shuttle pilot
- Lack of transportation is a known challenge to staffing, housing and visitor attraction.
- Explore the feasability of transit within Drumheller through a mix of research, expert analysis and community insights as a starting point to addressing this challenge.
- Develop and launch a pilot program that provides a summer fixed route weekend shuttle within the core area of Drumheller. The shuttle provides immediate value to the community and real world data to integreate into the feasability study and consider in exploring opportunities.
